#### Financial report: Colette

- Balances: Gaming and general
  - Gaming (50/50 and raffle tickets) can only be spent very specific ways; ex: Can not use gaming for concession (anything that we sell)
  - Colette has compiled a list of eligible and prohibited gaming fund use lists

- School Grant last year \$2,780 (money sent to the school from lotto money in BC)
- Opening Gaming balance: \$11,463.25
- Non-gaming: \$7,539.87
- A few reminders from Colette
  - If running an event, chairs can message Colette to get clarity on gaming vs non-gaming eligibility
  - Colette now has signing authority
